Dear Wilson residents:

The WRRRA Executive Committee invites both existing (and prospective) members to attend our upcoming AGM.

This is an excellent forum for discussing local issues with City of Canning representatives and other WRRRA members.

Founded in 1979, the association remains actively involved in pursuing major issues on behalf of its members.

Recent successes include:

- The city's support of downcoding sections of South Wilson & East Cannington (which is still pending State Government approval);
- The Riverton Bridge and Fern Road upgrades, including the widening of the pedestrian walkway on the bridge;

- Lobbying to prevent the closure of the Bentley Library;
- The State Government's announcement of a (conditional) ban of large trucks on Leach Highway, following the completion of Roe Highway Stage 7 (as recommended in WRRRA's submission);
- Additional city funding for Wilson footpaths and bike paths; and
- Improved Broadband Internet access.

Work in progress includes: Changes to our constitution, the CRRP dual-use path network, underground power & sewerage, Riverton Bridge kiosk upgrade, Centenary Park and Castledare's development plans.

We invite members to get more actively involved and consider becoming Committee Members.
