

Need to Justice of the Peace?

What is a Justice of the Peace? JP's are volunteers who are appointed to carry out a range of official administrative duties in the community. These include attesting affidavits, statutory declarations and certifying documents.

Find a Justice of the Peace in Wilson. A document witnessing centre operates from the Riverton Library Saturday 1.30pm to 2.30pm and Thursday 10.00am to 12.00pm. You don't need an appointment. Other centres can be found in Beckenham, East Victoria Park, Manning, Perth City, Willetton. You can find the complete list by Googling "find a Justice of the peace in your area".

If you are unable to attend a Document Witnessing Centre, you can find a JP in Wilson or nearby by using the online search facility on the page above.

WRRA recently received a City of Canning Small Community Grant which assists us to manage our member database. The City also helps WRRA by subsidising hire for the Wilson Community Hall.
